May: National Chip Your Dog Month

Micro-chipping your pet helps your pet find his way home to you if he ever becomes lost or separated from his family. Most veterinarians offer the procedure and it's completed in just a few minutes. The chip is about the size of a grain of rice and is placed just under the skin. It can be read by a special scanner (kind of like the handheld one the grocery store clerk uses).

One of the really nice things about the microchip is it is always with your dog. It's not like an ID tag on a slipped collar or a dog license that has the information rubbed off. The chip is safely stored just under your dog's skin. Plus, it's linked to you and your veterinarian. So even if you change phone numbers and forget to update your registration online, the chip is still linked to your veterinarian, who is very likely to have your current contact information.

Local Shelters and Humane Society Shelters often offer Chip discounts.

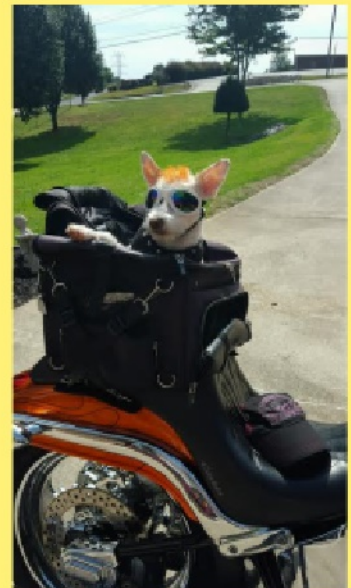
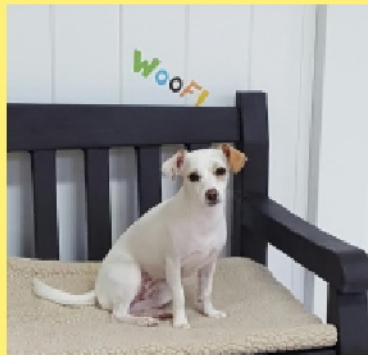

Deuce and Sophia love to play tug of war and go camping. They especially love the beach and children. We think Sophia looks a lot like the mascot in our DCC Golf logo



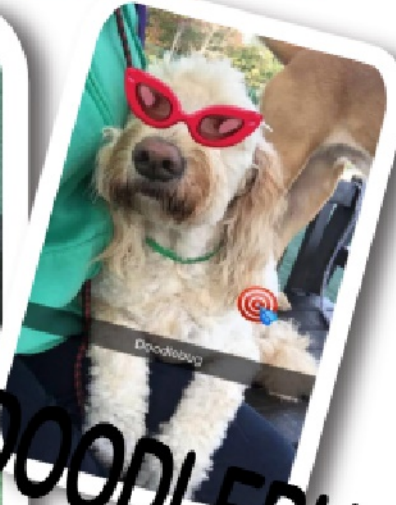

How To Pack for Fido!

Here are a few suggestions from our Caddies and Rovers of DCC that take care of your furry loved ones:

KIS! Keep It Simple!

- *Dry Dog food should be in a well sealed plastic container with a good lid
 - *You may provide a scoop, or ask for a measurement such as 1 cup
 - *or bring pre-bagged for each meal and include treats with the meal.
(but still put in a plastic container please)
- *Moist/can food should have your dogs name written on each container or box of containers.

MEDICATIONS

- *PLEASE Pack Separately in a Plastic Sealed Baggie with your Dogs Name

CHECK IN

- *Give yourself time at check-in with our Front Desk Staff
 - . how you would like your dogs food to be prepared
 - . review feeding schedule and medications administered
- *Large and Fluffy Dog Beds are Not Necessary**
- * we offer cots and fluffy sherpa blankets that will fit well in your dogs kennel and are best for keeping the Kennel clean.
- * a small (washable) blanket or T-shirt with your scent to snuggle with is best.
- *You **do not** need to provide toys...your baby will be well entertained during their stay
- *A rawhide or chew toy would be best for leaving in the kennel .
